Packing Accessories

Appropriate support is important for shipping. Use Insta-Pack foam or wrap the video card with bubble wrap or foam, ensuring all gaps are filled to minimize movement. The video card may sag or become dislodged due to its weight if not supported, which can cause damage to both the card and the PCle slot, particularly in heavier models.

NOTE: If possible, remove the video card and pack it separately using anti-static material.



Packaging Materials Checklist

- Carefully place your cushioned PC into a sturdy shipping box.
- Surround the PC on all sides with packing peanuts or foam to prevent movement during transit.
- Seal the box securely with packaging tape to keep it closed.
- Put the sealed box inside a larger shipping box. Add extra cushioning, such as packing peanuts or foam, between the inner and outer boxes for added protection.
- Seal the outer box securely on all sides to ensure it stays closed throughout shipping.



Packing Accessories

Pack accessories, such as power cables, manuals, and other peripherals, in a separate box or compartment within the shipping container. Use adequate padding materials like bubble wrap, foam sheets, or packing paper to prevent items from shifting and to protect them from damage during transit. Securely seal the accessory box or compartment and ensure it is clearly labeled. Before sealing the main box, double-check that there are no loose items inside that could move around and cause potential damage to the PC or accessories during shipping.

Common Mistakes to Avoid

- Do not use a single box without double boxing.
- Do not leave the video card unsupported.
- · Do not use insufficient cushioning.
- · Do not leave any sides unsealed.

Important: Improper packaging can result in damage during shipping. Always double-box and use adequate cushioning for every shipment.
